Your one-stop-shop for health and housing solutions

Living in a cold or damp home can be a risk to your health. The National Energy Foundation (NEF) is delivering **Better Housing, Better Health** in partnership with 11 local authorities and the NHS across Oxfordshire and Buckinghamshire to improve health and wellbeing for those living with health conditions which may be impacted by living in a cold or damp home. The scheme runs until December 2016.

How we can help

We can offer:

- Grants of up to £2,500 for energy efficiency measures for homeowners with a respiratory illness or cardiovascular disease.
- Free surveys to identify potential risks to health for homeowners and private tenants with a respiratory illness or cardiovascular disease.
- Benefits checks, fuel debt mediation and assistance with switching energy tariff or supplier from two dedicated Citizens Advice caseworkers for homeowners, private tenants or social tenants in need of support.

Eligibility Criteria

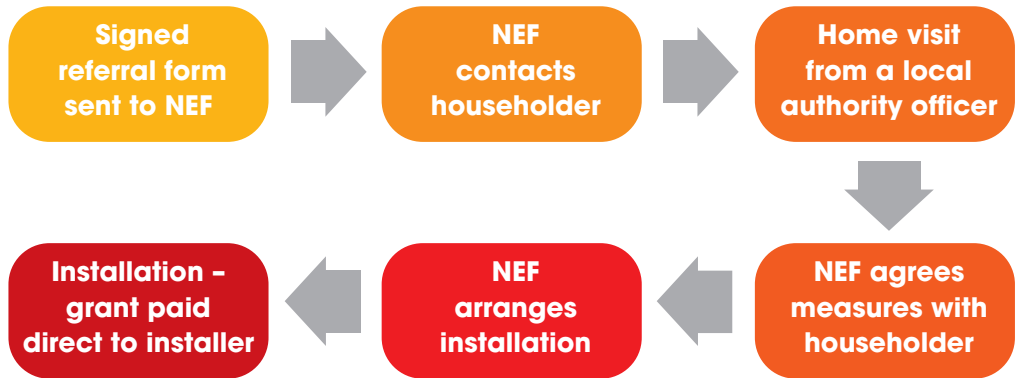
The scheme is only available in Buckinghamshire (excluding Milton Keynes) and Oxfordshire for residents who have a **cardiovascular disease or respiratory illness**. Residents are particularly at risk if they are part of a vulnerable group:

- Over 65s
- Low income households
- Families with children under 5
- People with disabilities
- People with mental health issues

Referral Process

Referrals must be signed by a **health or social care professional** with access to verified health information. To request a referral, download a referral form from www.nef.org.uk/bhbh and ask your health or social care professional (such as a GP, nurse, health visitor or social worker) to sign it.

The process for eligible homeowners to receive energy efficiency measures through the Better Housing, Better Health grant is as follows:
