Why was HECA revised in 2012?

- Green Deal/Area based approach
- Localism agenda
- Recognition of realities on the ground
- Central data now produced and published

Further reports:

“prepare reports by 31 March 2013 setting out the energy conservation measures that the authority considers practicable, cost-effective and likely to result in significant improvement in the energy efficiency of residential accommodation in its area”

Progress reports (every 2 years):

“..prepare, publish and send to SoS, reports on the progress made in implementing the measures set out in the report.”

- 303 reports (92% of LAs)

Highlights:

- c3/4 set out progress on reducing CO₂;
- many plans to use Green Deal/ECO & FITs;
- c1/3 working with private rented sector;
- many strong local partnerships

To cover:

- progress on 2013 report e.g. on targets set and update plans in 2013;
- revise if plans have changed significantly.

- £86.4m to 24 projects

What makes a successful project?:

- coherent customer journey;
- strong incentives;
- right target areas;
